Pandemic Plan of Action

Beginning on Monday, March 16, 2020

- Schools are closed to students through at least March 27, 2020.
- Essential staff are to report to work on Monday, March 16, 2020.
- Essential staff includes central office staff, principals, assistant principals, head teachers, school secretaries, nurses, counselors, aides, Community in School staff, maintenance and custodial staff, food service staff, and all transportation staff.
- During this closure, we will be making sure meals are available to students. Beginning Monday, March 16, Grab-n-Go meals will be available at the schools below between 10 AM and 1 PM. Students may pick up meals at any location, regardless of which school they attend. All meals will be free to students. We will be working to expand meal service to include bus stop deliveries.
- Counselors, Community in Schools staff, and school nurses are to begin making contact with at-risk students to ascertain needs and begin coordinating support services. School facilities will be available for their use if needed.
- Teachers and other personnel are to be working, regularly checking emails, preparing packets for all academic areas through March 27th to be available to students no later than end of the day on Thursday, March 19, 2020. School facilities will be available for teaching and professional staff if they need a place to work or retrieve materials for planning purposes. Regardless of the location where the preparation work occurs, all materials must be completed and compiled for distribution by Thursday, March 19, 2020, for a period extending to at least March 27, 2020.

Beginning Thursday, March 19, 2020

- All staff report to work beginning on Thursday, March 19, 2020.
- Schools may employ social distancing to provide some level of isolation for staff members with documented cases of immune deficiency or other serious health concerns.
