(KA) The recommended items that your child needs are...

- Four boxes of regular size crayons (*Crayola - 8 pack)
- Three (4 oz.) bottles of *Elmer's washable, white glue, orange tip
- Three large size glue sticks and three small size glue sticks
- Backpack (regular size not small) - no drawstrings or wheels
- We recommend the purchase of a Kindermat (four-fold) for your child. This is available at Wal-Mart, Staples, etc. (The Preschool teacher may have brought your child's mat to Kindergarten, if it's still usable).
- One large roll of paper towels (*Bounty preferred)
- An extra change of clothes in a labeled *Hefty bag.
- One-quart size box of *Hefty or *Ziploc plastic bags
- One pack of napkins
- Three containers of *Lysol disinfectant sanitary wipes
- One pack - 9oz. plastic cups
- **Velcro tennis shoes for PE that will be kept at school
- You may purchase headphones for your child to be used in computer lab, if you do not want to purchase headphones then your child may use headphones provided by FES - Your purchased ones will only be used by your child and kept at school

Recognize/name letters of alphabet and know some sounds

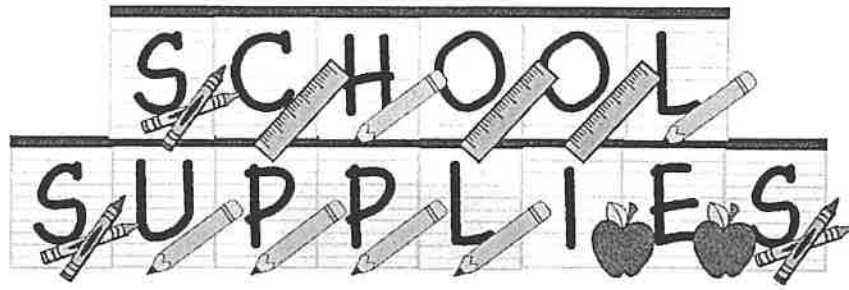
Recite telephone number and address.

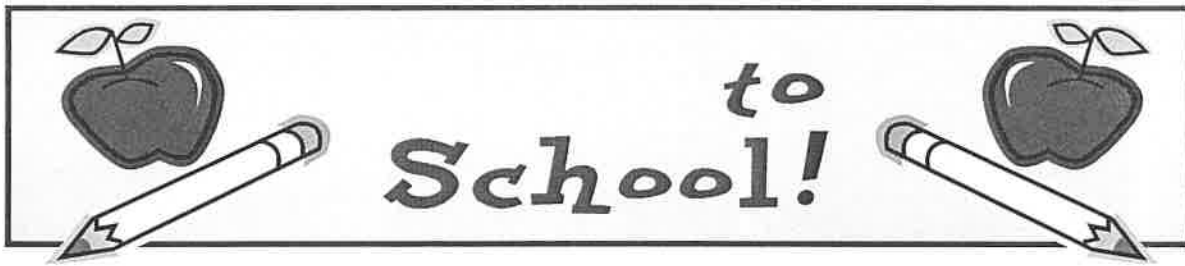
Suggested Supplies:
